<b>授業の内容</b>
<p>What is gender? How is it different from sex? What are the problems facing men? women? sexual minorities? While these questions may seemingly be easy to answer at first, once we delve a little deeper we may find that they may not be so easy to answer and in fact just raise more questions.</p> <p>In this course, we will take a look at the concept of gender and the role it plays in societies around the world. We will also look at gender and how it relates to religion, sex, psychology, etc. We will use a vast array of resources including but not limited to films, current events, excerpts and personal experiences. The hope is that this class will be both intellectually stimulating and enjoyable. The goal is that, by the end of this course, we will have a better understanding of gender, how it pertains to our lives and what we can do to advance the field so that it is accessible to more people.</p>

<p>The majority of class time will be dedicated to class discussions. There will be required reading assignments every week. Students will also be asked to write a short reflection paper on the topics covered in the previous class each week.</p> <p>If the class has to be done remotely due to the COVID-19, we will use Zoom.</p>
