授業の内容
This course introduces basic concepts of bilingualism. Issues to be covered include bilingual and second language studies, such as bilingual individuals (adult and children) and how they acquire or maintain two or more languages in various settings. Instructed in English, this course is designed for the following students: international students, upper-intermediate and advanced level students who wish to study abroad, or who have returned from their study-abroad experience. FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS: It is highly recommended that first-year students contact the instructor (email: rtakeda@seijo.ac.jp) for an interview in English on Zoom before the first week of classes in April.
到達目標
Students are expected to understand and apply concepts of bilingualism in a variety of contexts.
授業の方法
Classes will be offered online. While there will be pre-recorded video lectures via WebClass, most of the classes will be conducted on Zoom. Students will engage in class activities, such as discussions and group work. The syllabus is subject to change, contingent upon availability of guest speakers (bilingual professional and/or bilingual Seijo student).

Special bilinguals (2) (Zoom class) 12. Personality, thinking and dreaming, and emotions in bilinguals (Zoom class) 13. Review (Zoom class) 14. Final presentations (1) (Zoom class) 15. Final presentations (2) (Zoom class)
